

## Inviting Family or Friends to the U.S.

While studying at SNHU, you may want to invite a family member to come visit you or attend your graduation ceremony. Generally, they will need to apply for a B-2 tourist visa or enter under the Visa Waiver Program; further guidance about this process may be found on the U.S. Embassy website from where they will apply.

- 1. You may wish to write them a letter of invitation which the guest(s) can take to their visa appointment, although it is not required by the Department of State.
- 2. Consider providing a copy of either of the following documents from SNHU: a copy of your Form I-20/DS-2019 or an enrollment verification letter.

Please remember: the Commencement and International Student Services offices do not issue letters of invitation- these must come from you!

Please write your own personalized letter to your guest(s). Below is ONLY a sample and you must write your own unique letter and not copy this sample.
